 - Sign a funding agreement that outlines the conditions of funding. If you are under 18, your parent / guardian will need to co-sign the agreement.
- A funding acquittal form must be completed and received by the Maldon & District Community Bank at the completion of your year of study in 2022. The acquittal form will be included with correspondence confirming funding or can be requested by contacting the Executive Officer or branches.
